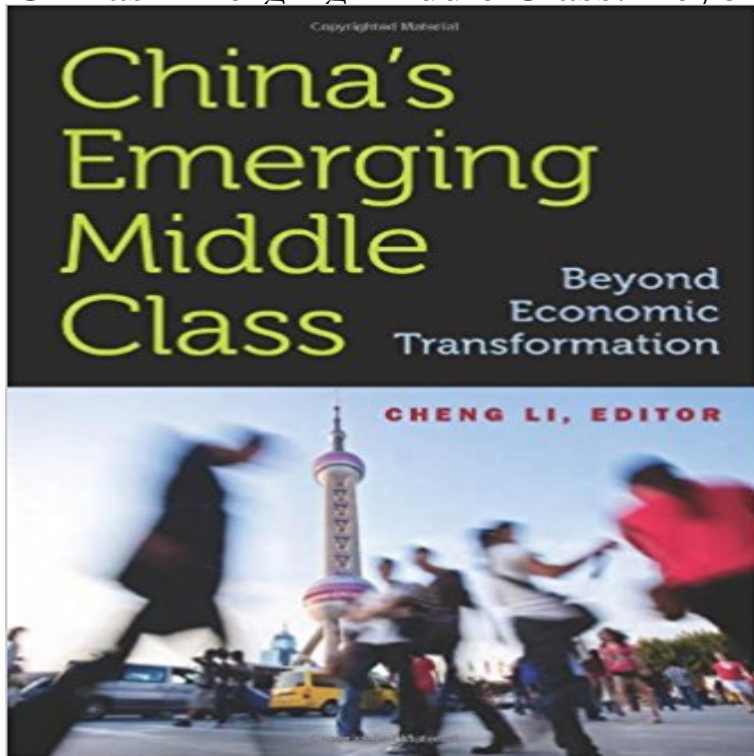


Chinas Emerging Middle Class: Beyond Economic Transformation
