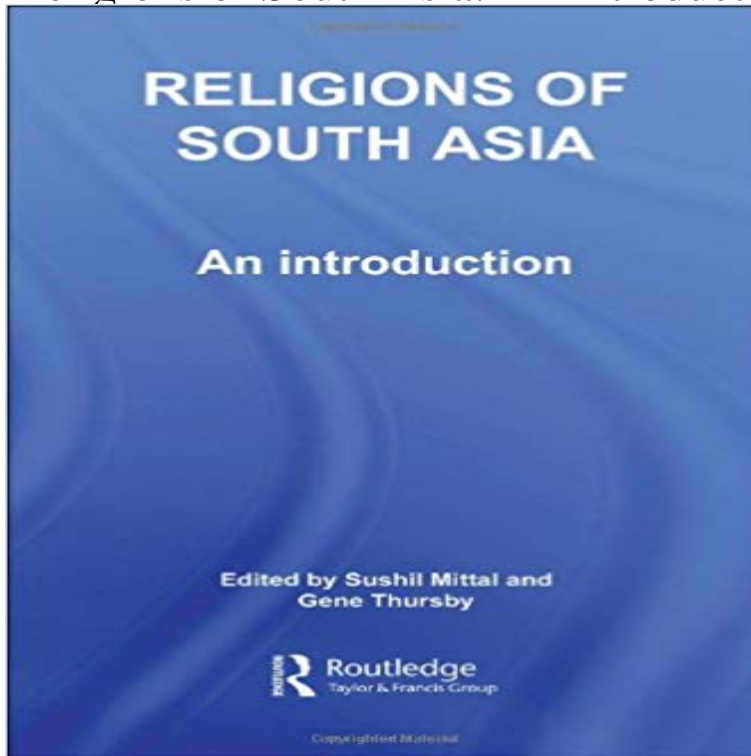


Religions of South Asia: An Introduction
