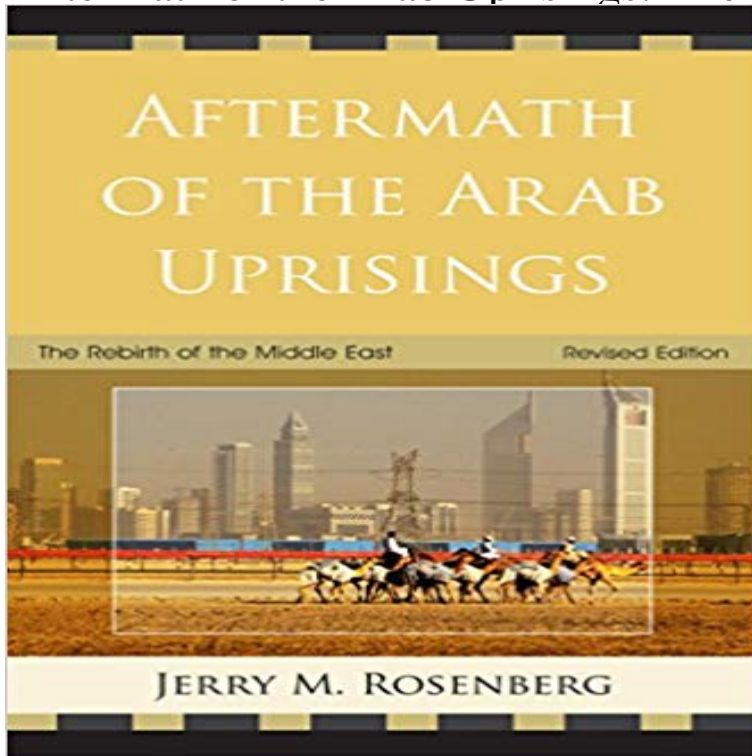


Aftermath of the Arab Uprisings: The Rebirth of the Middle East
