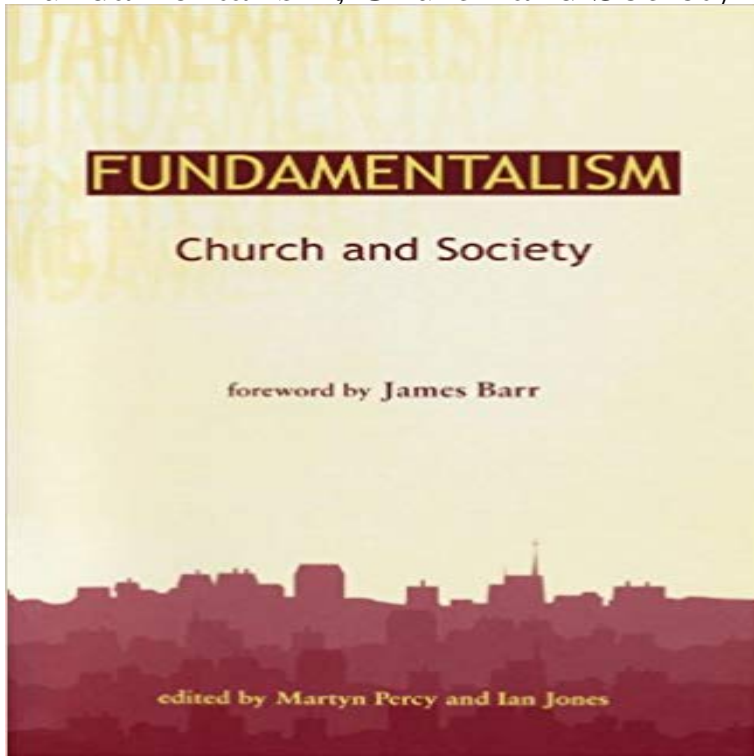


Fundamentalism, Church and Society
