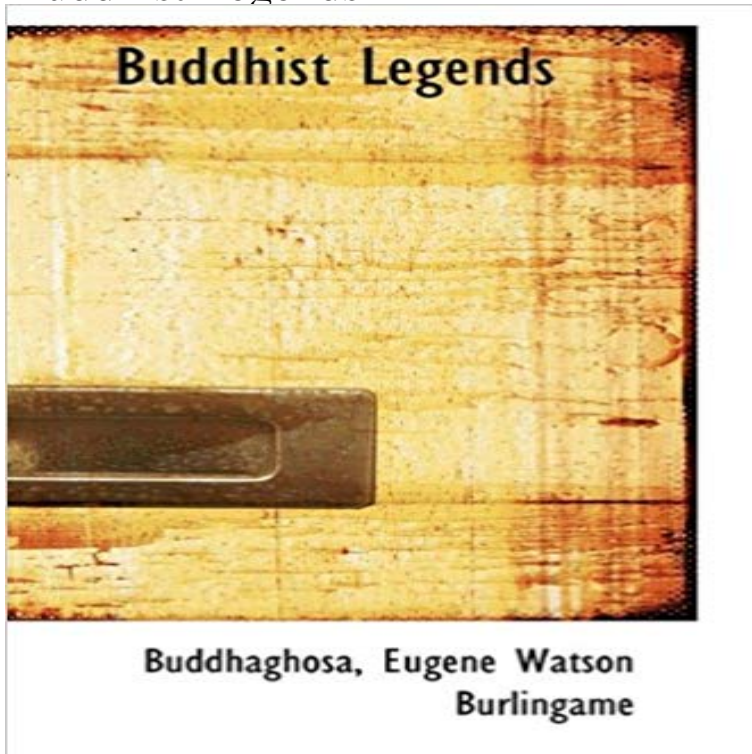


Buddhist Legends
