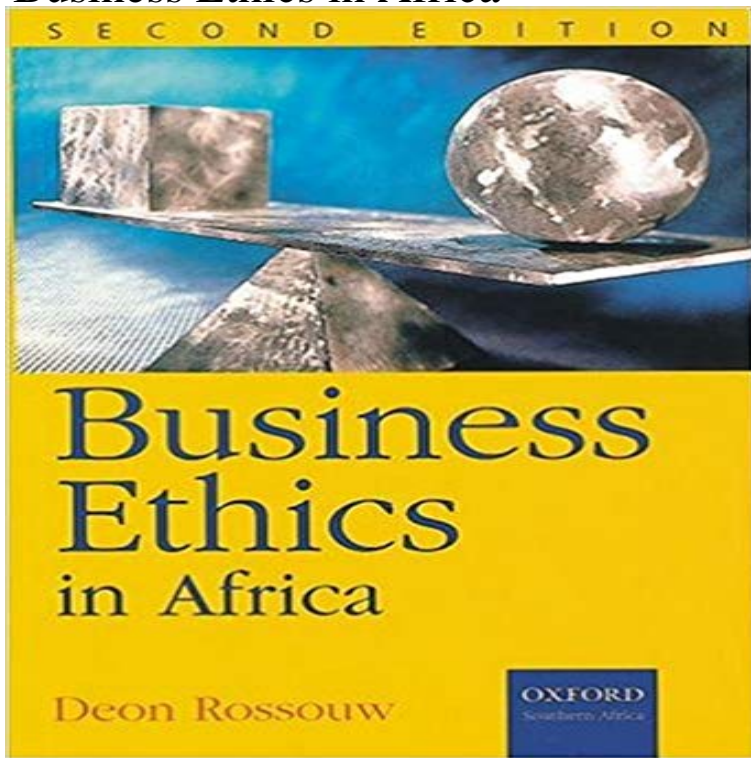


Business Ethics in Africa
