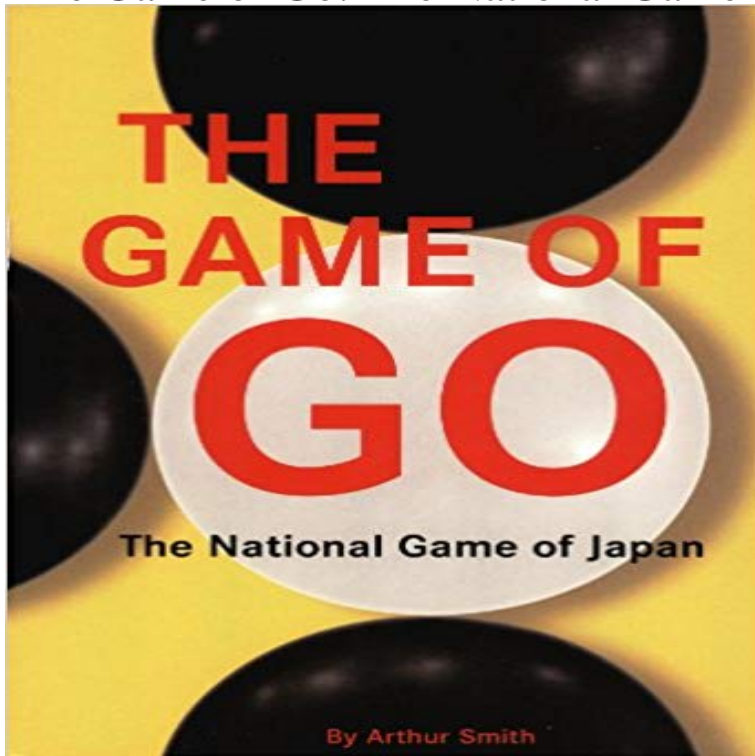


## The Game of Go: The National Game of Japan
