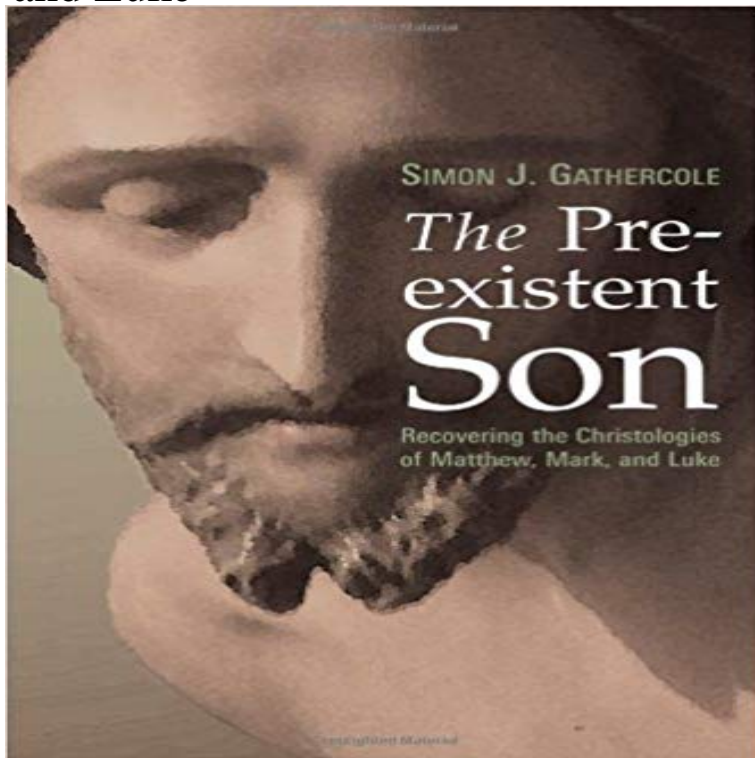


The Preexistent Son: Recovering the Christologies of Matthew, Mark, and Luke
