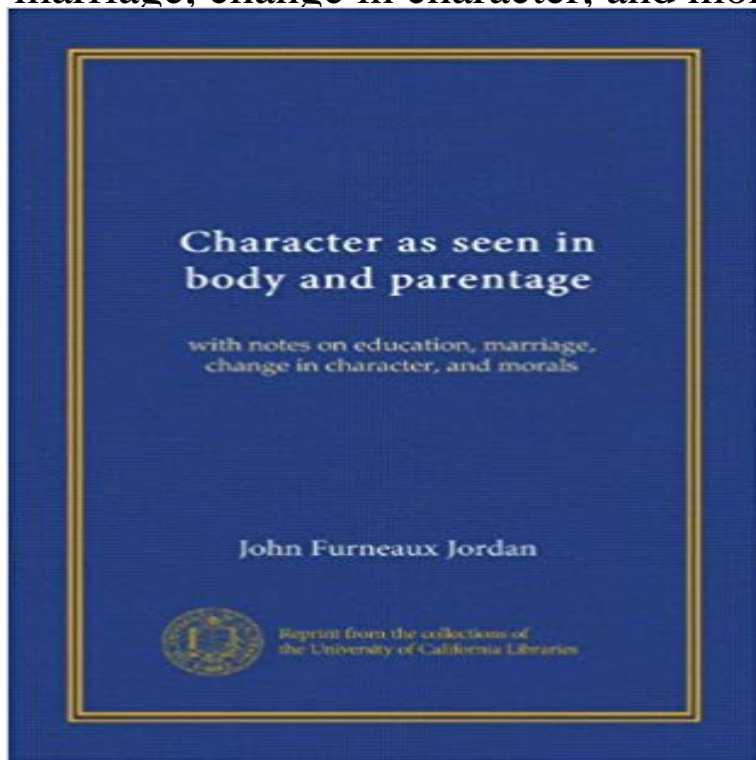


## Character as seen in body and parentage: with notes on education, marriage, change in character, and morals
