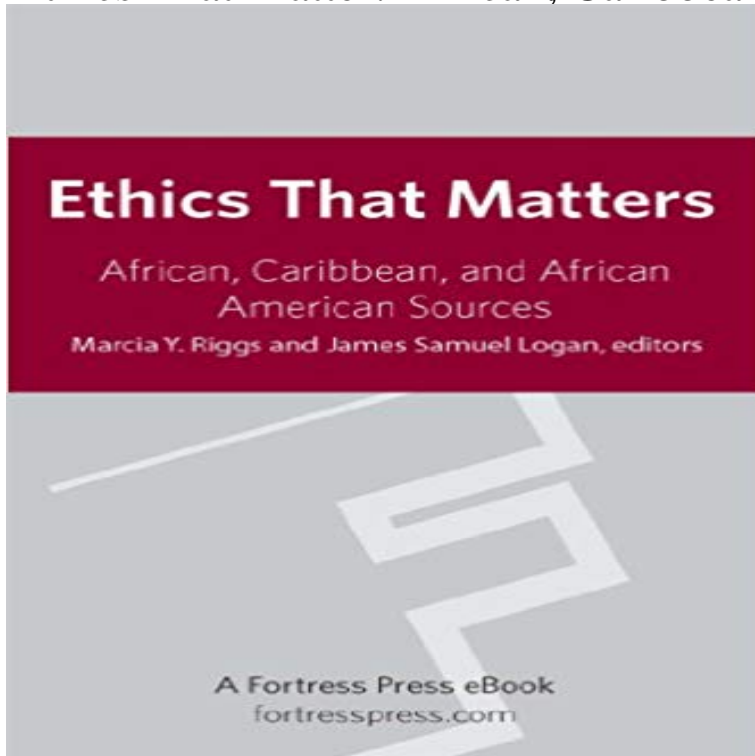


Ethics That Matter: African, Caribbean, And African American Sources
