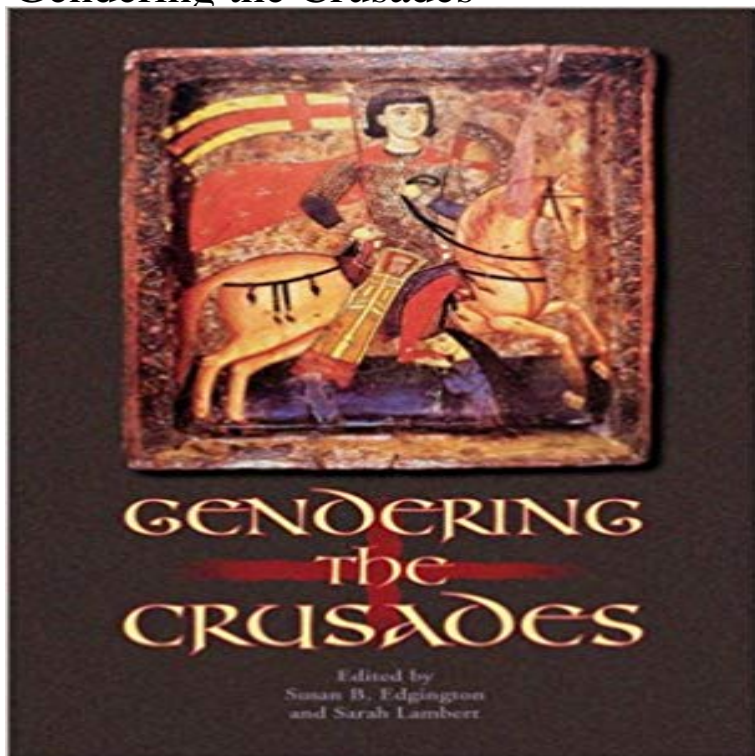


## Gendering the Crusades
