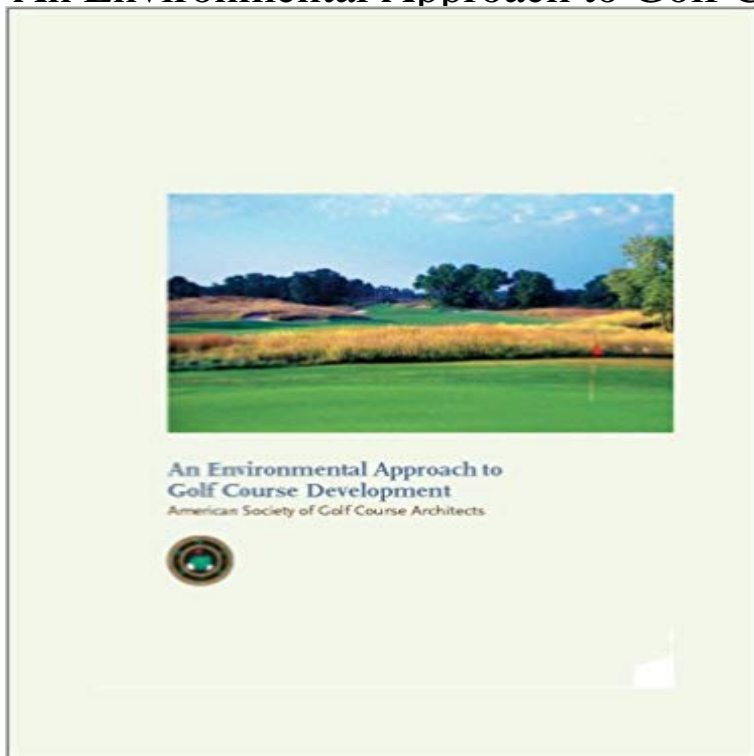


An Environmental Approach to Golf Course Development
