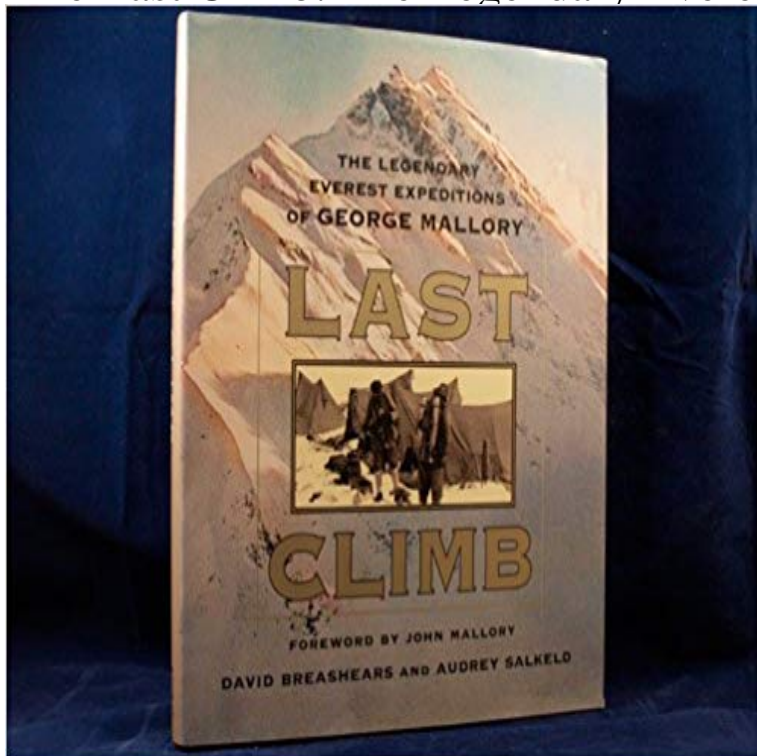


The Last Climb: The Legendary Everest Expeditions of George Mallory
