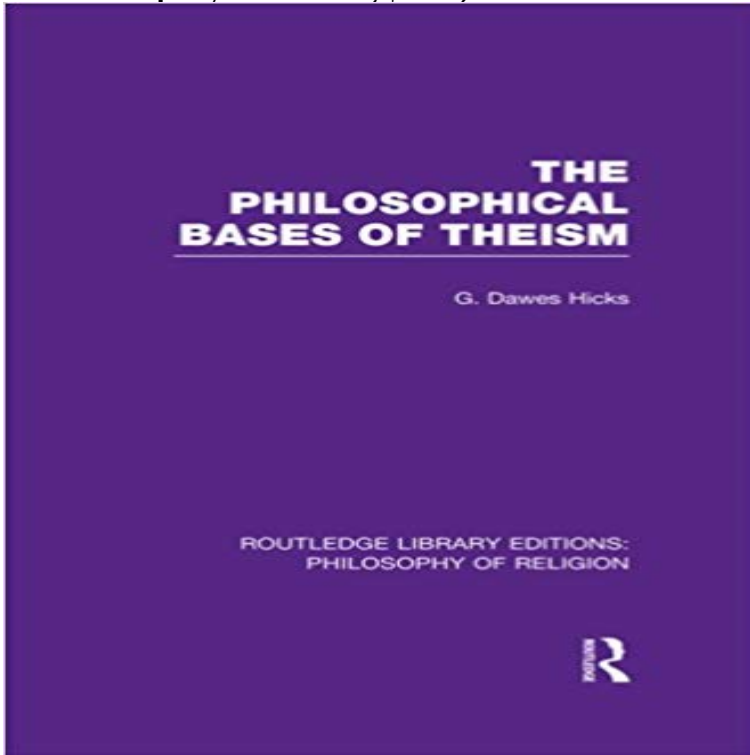


The Philosophical Bases of Theism (Routledge Library Editions: Philosophy of Religion)
