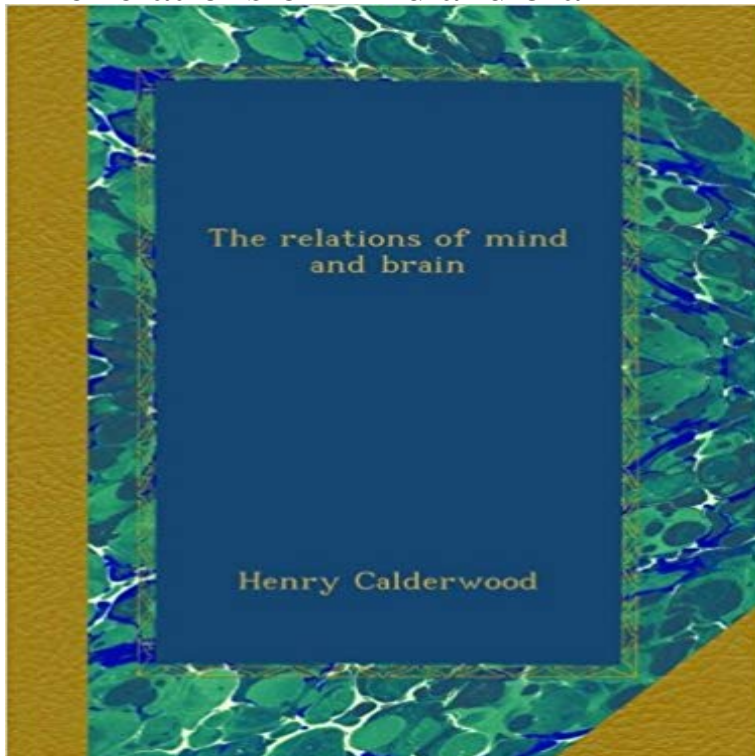


## The relations of mind and brain
