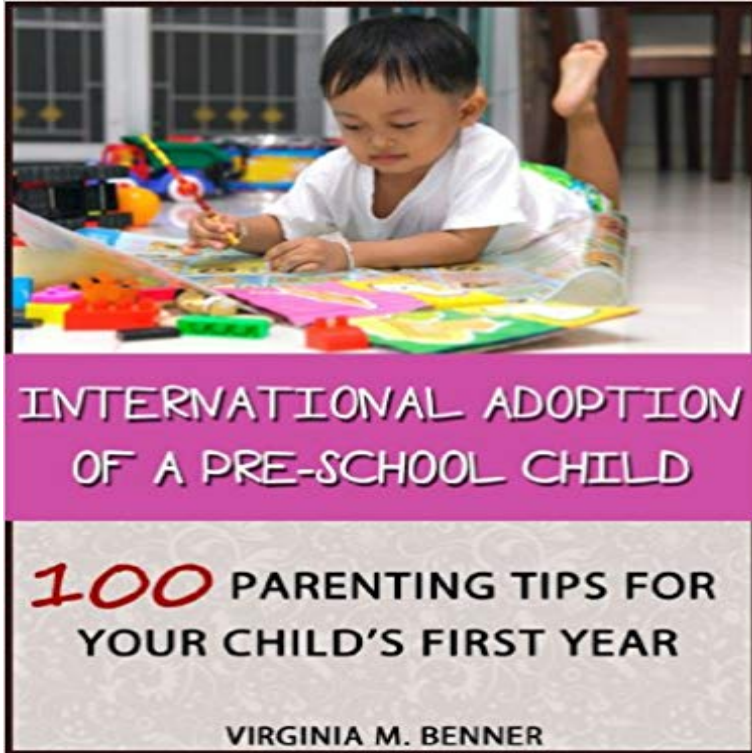


International Adoption of a Pre-school Child: 100 Parenting Tips for Your Child's First Year
