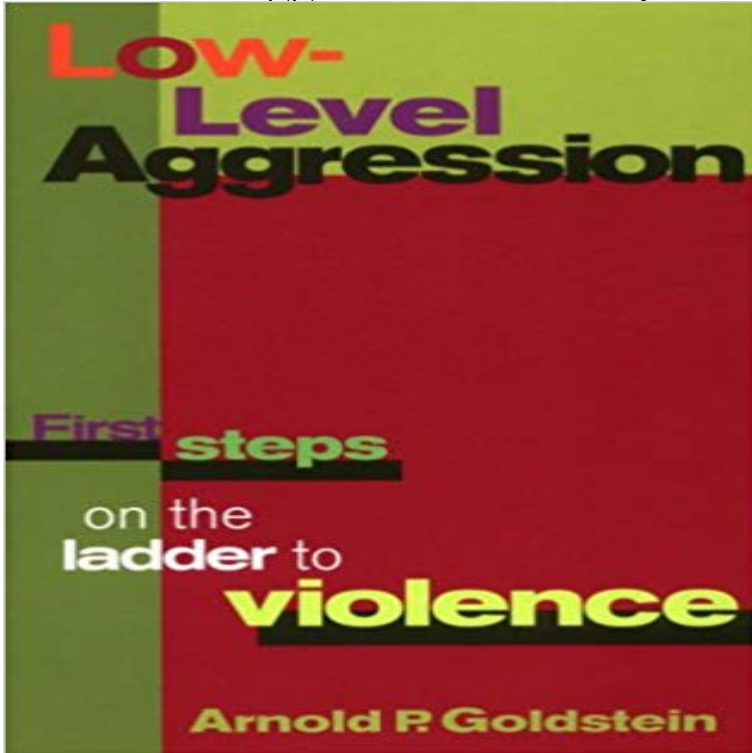


## Low Level Aggression: First Steps on the Ladder to Violence
