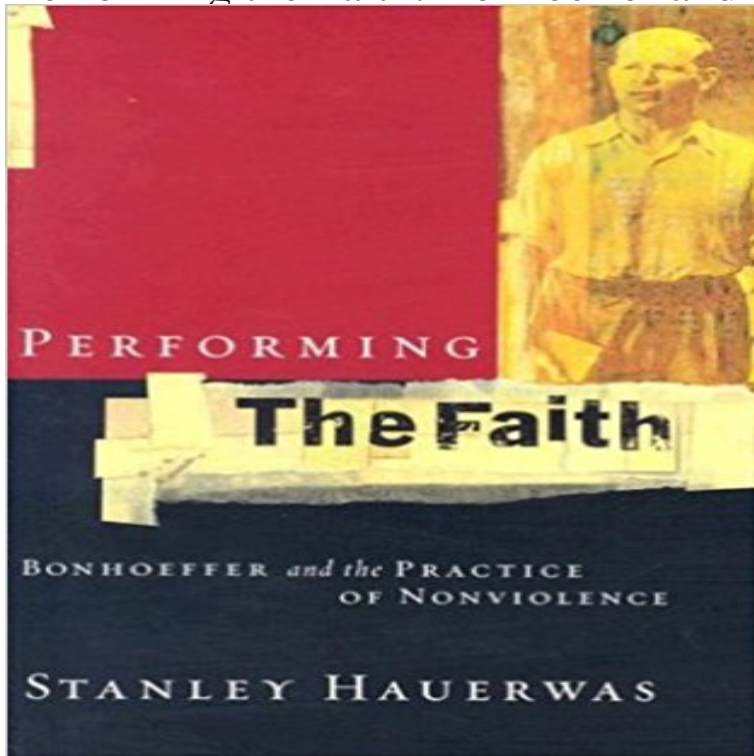


Performing the Faith: Bonhoeffer and the Practice of Nonviolence
