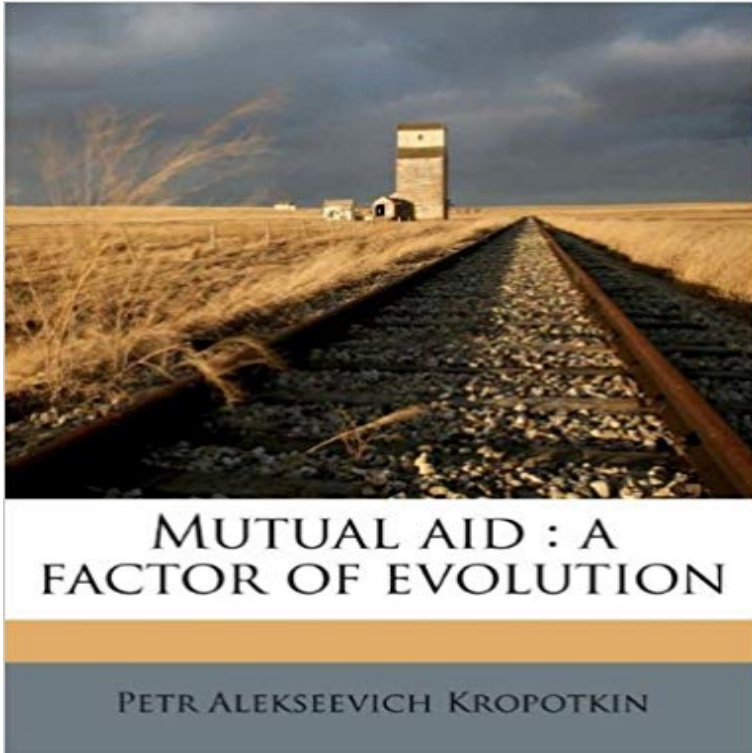


Mutual aid: a factor of evolution
