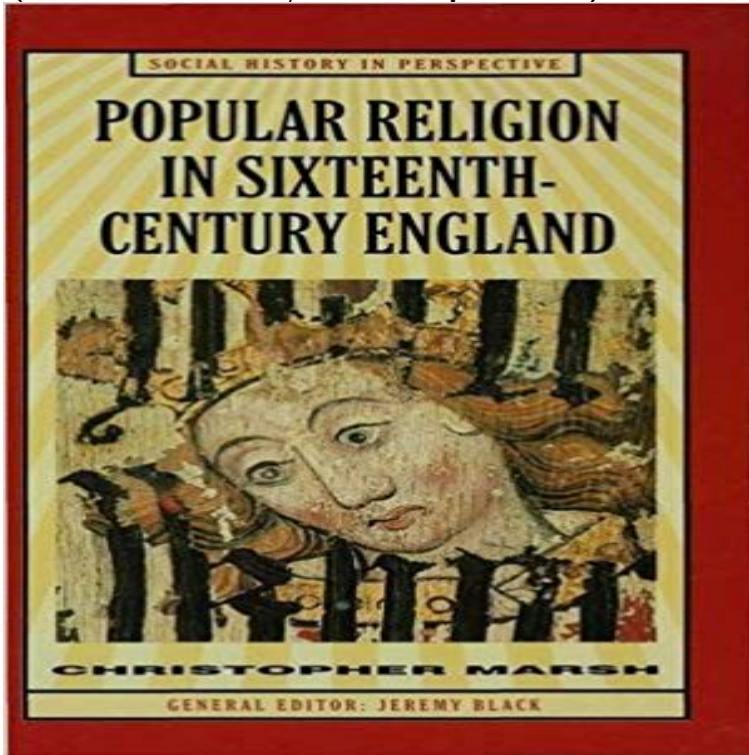


Popular Religion in Sixteenth-Century England: Holding Their Peace (Social History in Perspective)
