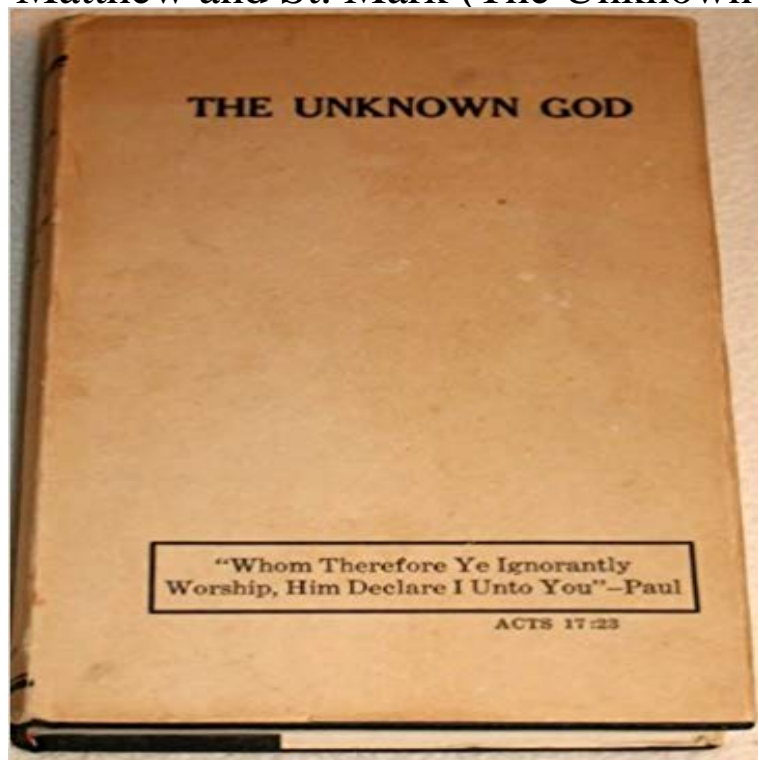


The Unknown God: The Teachings of Jesus of Nazareth According to St. Matthew and St. Mark (The Unknown God, Volume 1)
