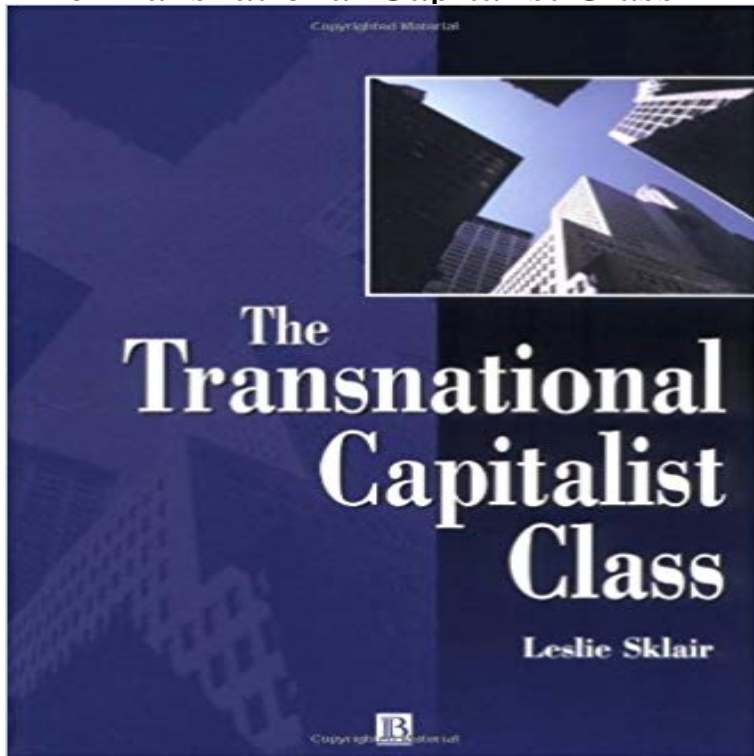


The Transnational Capitalist Class
