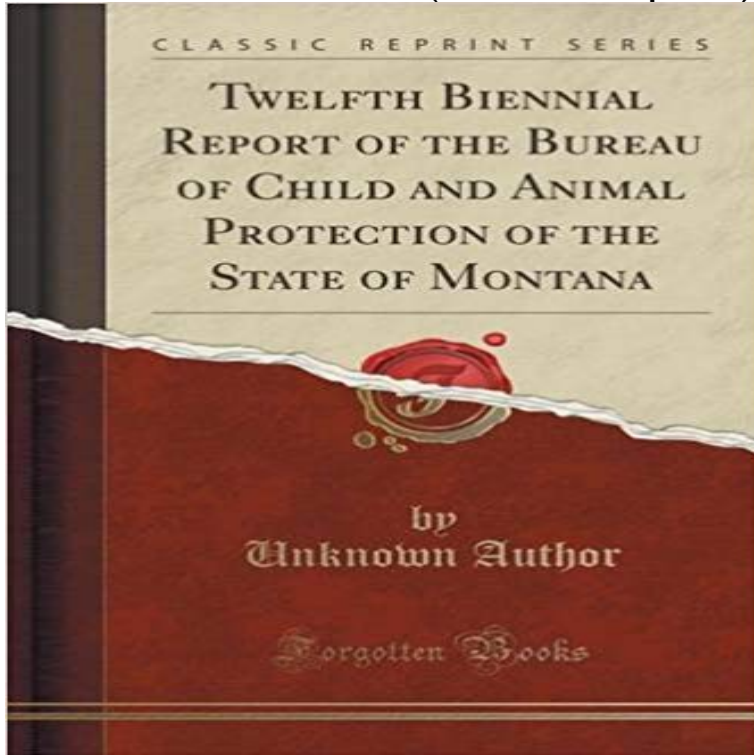


Twelfth Biennial Report of the Bureau of Child and Animal Protection of the State of Montana (Classic Reprint)



Excerpt from Twelfth Biennial Report of the Bureau of Child and Animal Protection of the State of Montana. The State Bureau of Child and Animal Protection was created by an Act of the Legislature twenty years ago. In the following pages we shall endeavor to give an outline of the work it is doing. In a general way it has to deal with the youth of the state, although quite often cases are brought to us of domestic differences and of elderly persons who are not getting the help they are entitled to from relatives, so in fact we are a sort of clearing house for troubles, and are glad to relate that by interviews with the parties directly connected we have often been able to adjust without publicity what might have resulted in legal procedure. Cases of dependent, delinquent, neglected, deserted and destitute children and cases of cruelty to animals come under the supervision of this Bureau. Montana has fifty-five counties covering 146,997 square miles, these counties are divided into districts and six deputies together with the Secretary cover the entire area. To the State Deputy, or Placement Officer is assigned the duty of placing children in private homes either for legal adoption or for care and education. Each case brought to our attention has its own peculiar angles and has to be considered not only from a point of law but from the humane side, what might be the best way to solve the problem of one child, would not be the correct or proper way to handle that of another. It may be interesting to note that under the former administration during the years, 1918 to 1921, there was expended for the Bureau \$69,633.71, while under the present administration, for the years 1921 to 1924, the expenditures were \$52,268.94, thus showing a saving during the past three years over the other administration of \$17,364.77.
