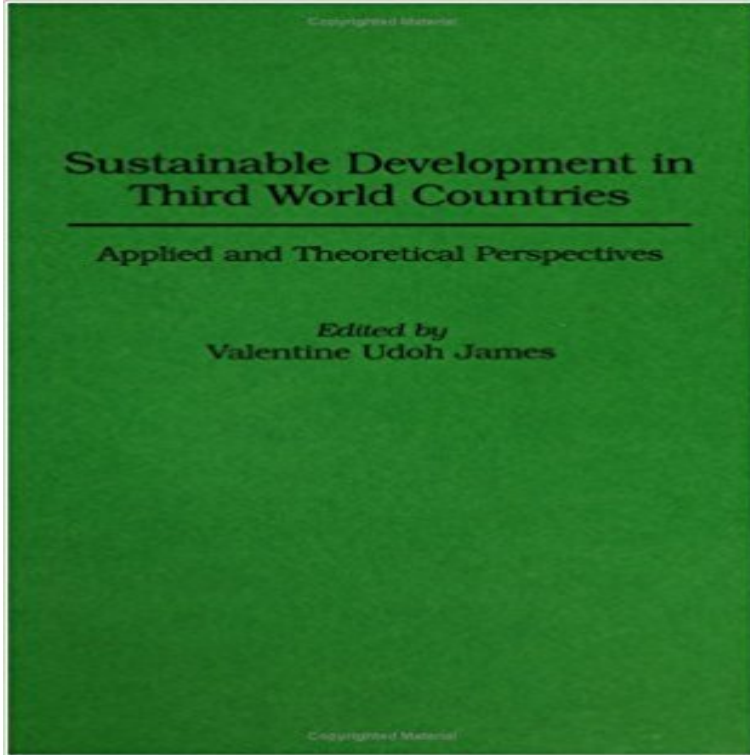


Sustainable Development in Third World Countries: Applied and Theoretical Perspectives (Medical Studies; 12)
