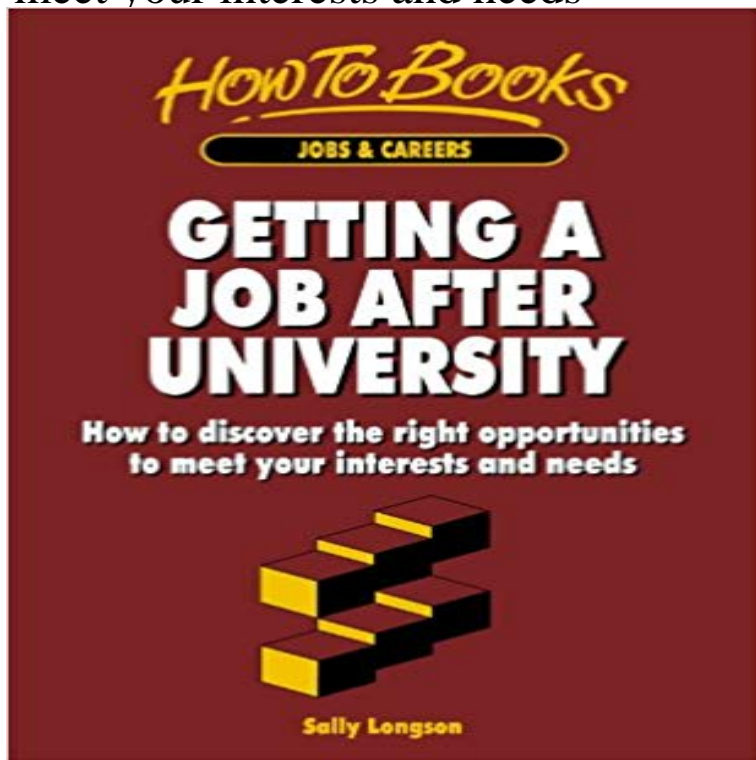


## Getting a Job After University: How to discover the right opportunities to meet your interests and needs
