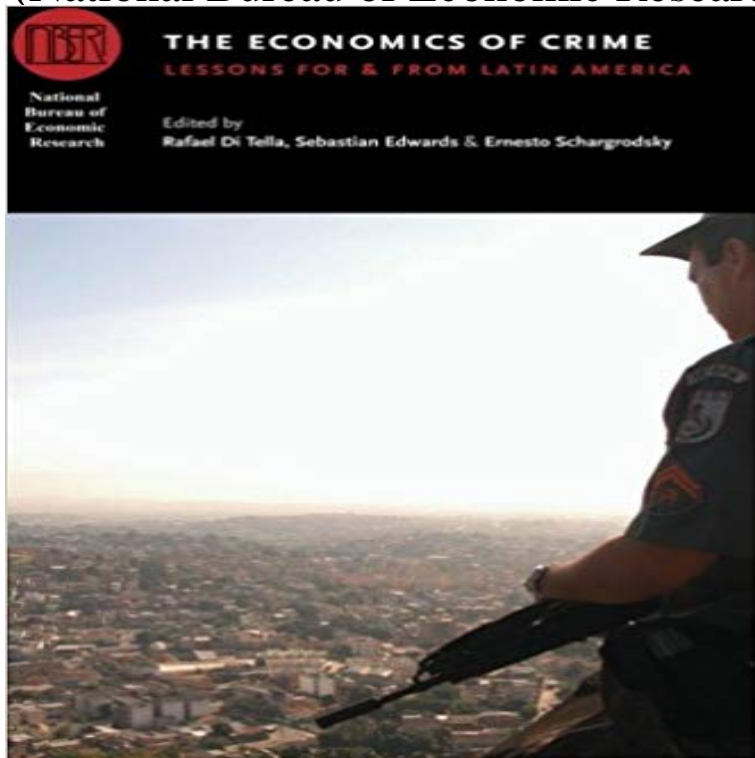


The Economics of Crime: Lessons For and From Latin America (National Bureau of Economic Research Conference Report)
