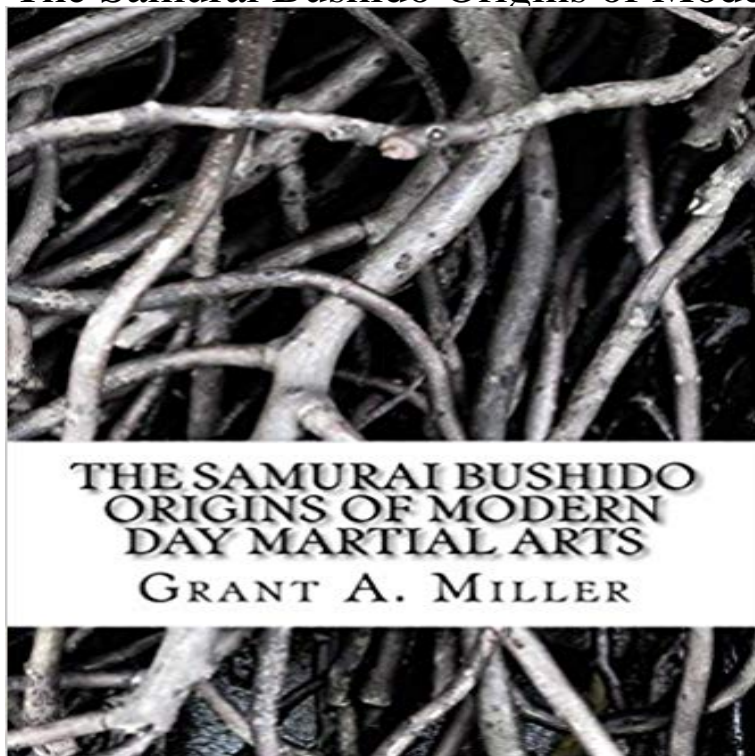


## The Samurai Bushido Origins of Modern Day Martial Arts
