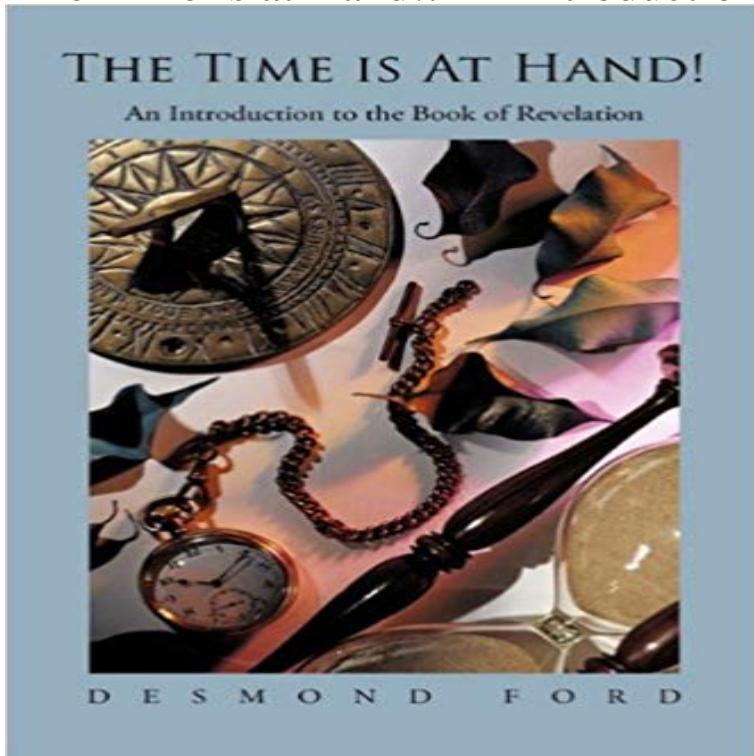


The Time Is at Hand!: An Introduction to the Book of Revelation
