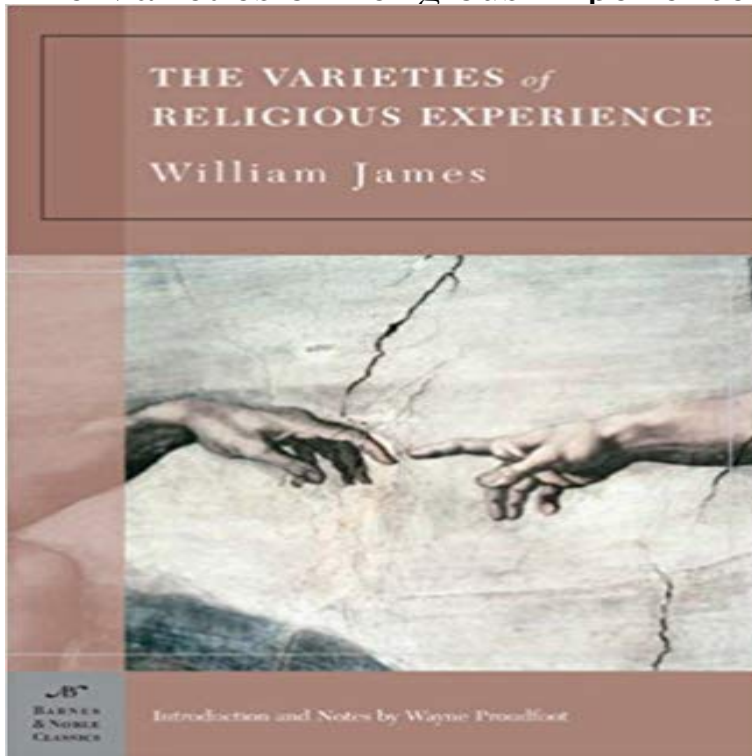

Many of his categories including the sick soul, the divided self, and healthy-mindedness have become standard in the study of religions. Exquisitely written, *The Varieties of Religious Experience* has had a profound influence on modern spiritual thought, including the psychology of religion and recovery programs such as Alcoholics Anonymous.
