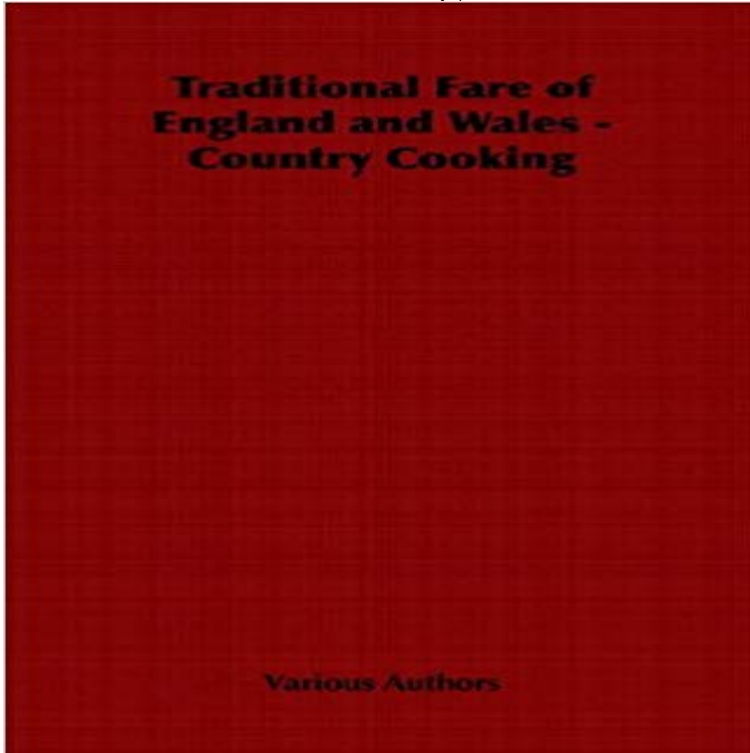


## Traditional Fare of England and Wales - Country Cooking
