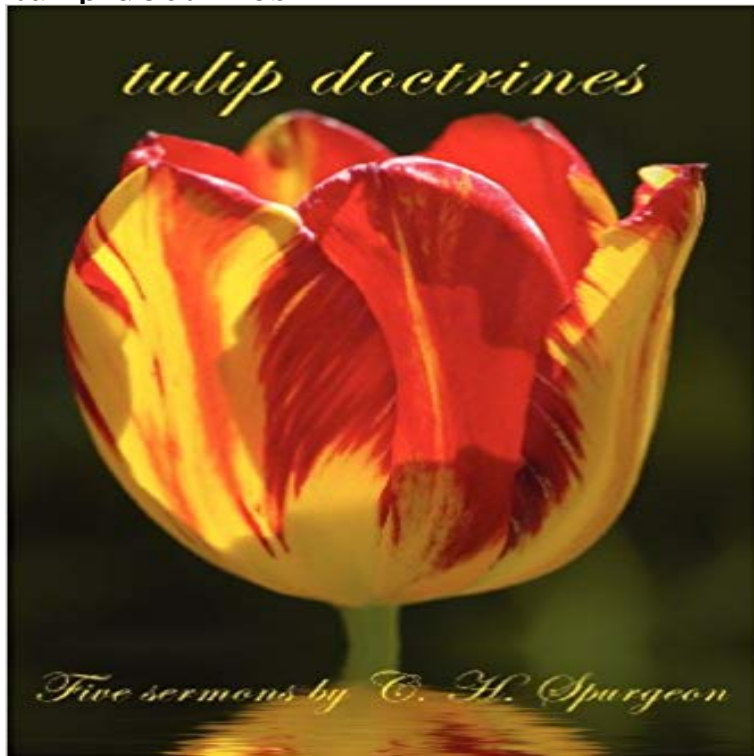


## tulip doctrines
