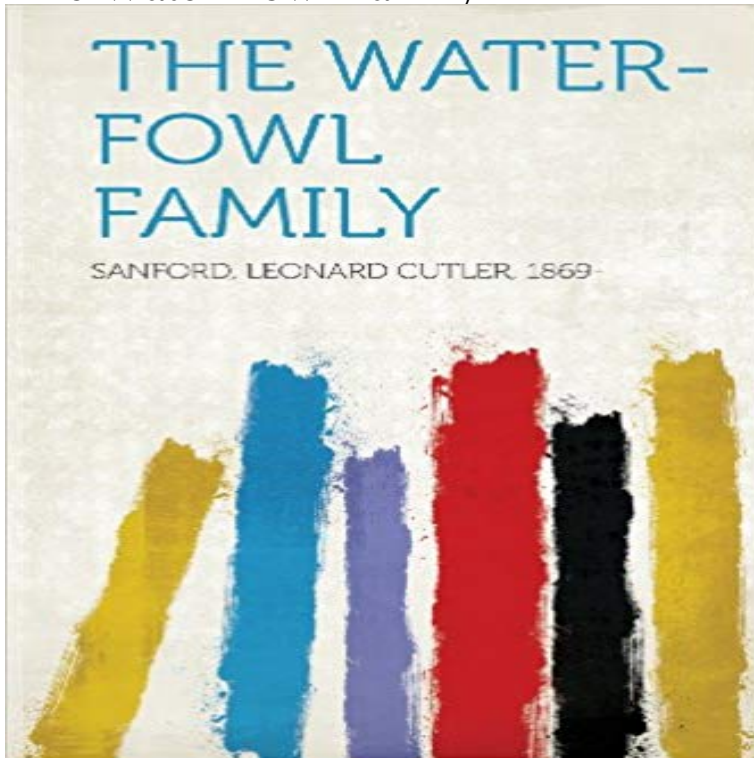


## The Water-Fowl Family
