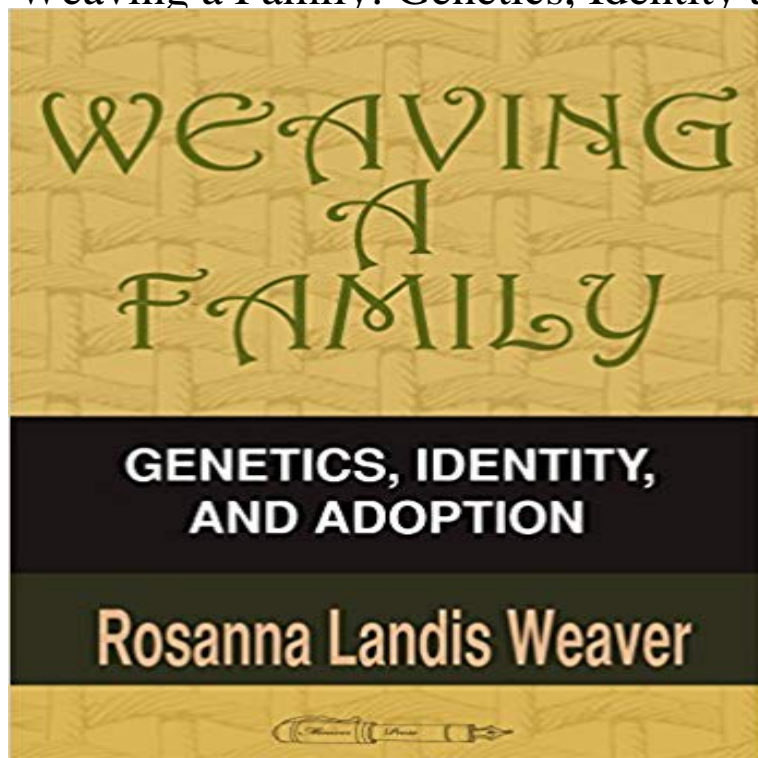


Weaving a Family: Genetics, Identity and Adoption
