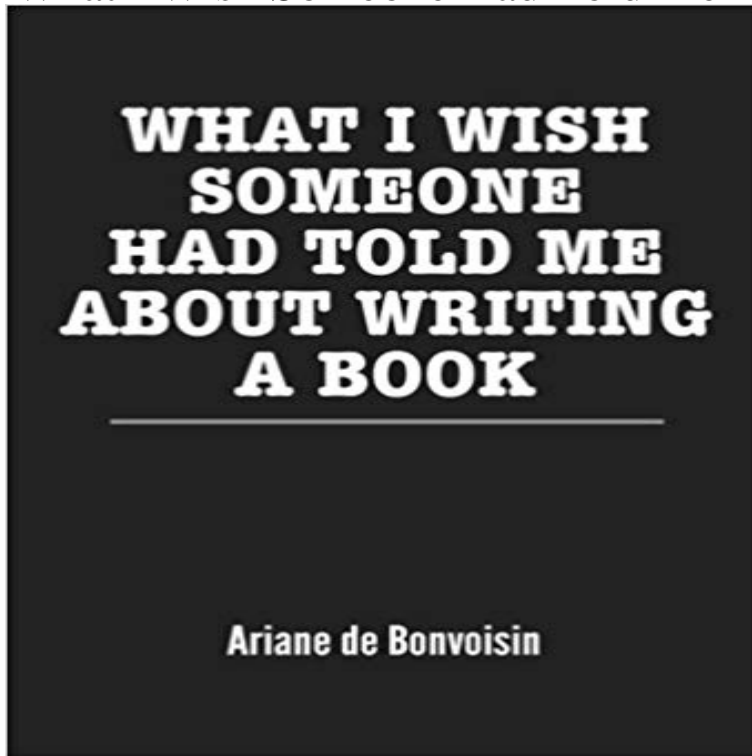


What I Wish Someone Had Told Me About Writing A Book
