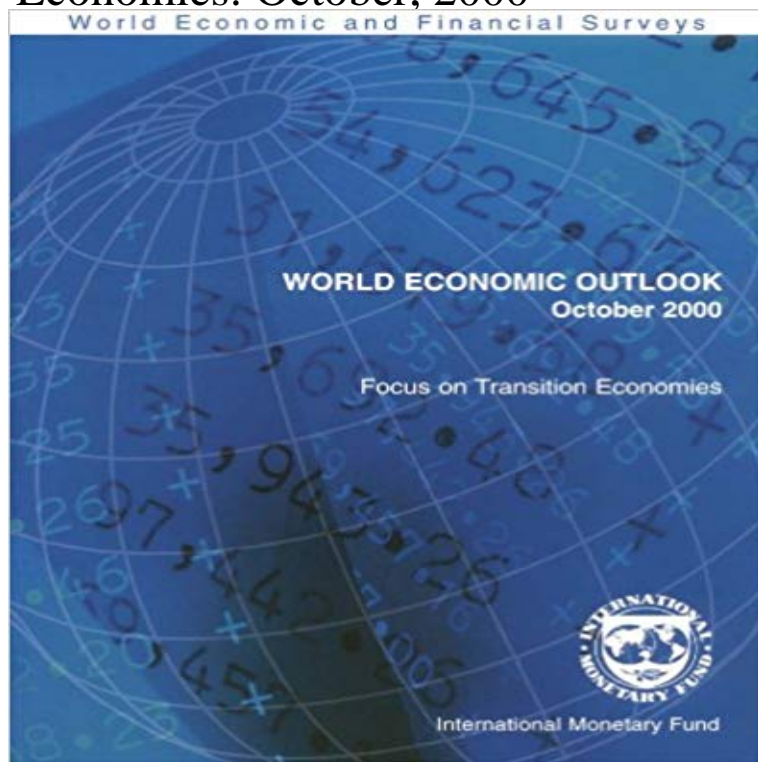


# World Economic Outlook, October 2000: Focus on Transition Economies: October, 2000
